





It can be a chance to develop local economy


Communities in remote areas can expect the rise in sales figures in local shops as well as having more opportunities to develop their tourism industry.

 The environment in remote places can be seriously harmed by human activities


As the environment in those areas is vulnerable and fragile, it can be easily damaged if the number of people increases.


 Local people may suffer from various pollution



Introduction



Main body 1






