- Write by hand like handwriting, useful for making quick notes


It depends. If I need to make personal notes, I usually write by hand but if I have write something for work, I type it on the computer.

- No; still many people like writing by hands


Yes, it's quite obvious I think. Loads of people prefer to use computers when they need to write something, and this trend won't get changed.




