I prefer mornings. As I'm a morning person, I can concentrate a lot better in the mornings. So whenever I need to study, I normally start at around 9 am.



I much prefer to study alone. I can't really concentrate when there's someone around me, so I normally find somewhere where I can stay alone then focus.






Well, one of my favourite buildings is 'The Shard' in London, England. I used to visit neighbouring towns to see that building, and took loads of pictures of it.


It's divided in different sections; there are some restaurants on first few floors, hotels and residential areas in the middle sections, and also an observatory at the top floors.



Well, I like this building because I love its observatory.


